

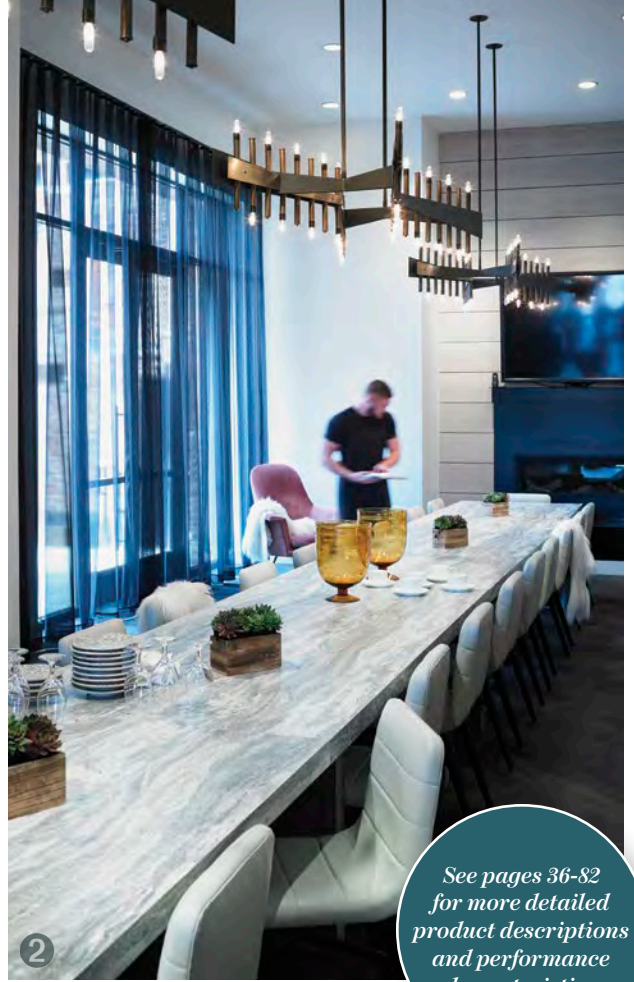
HOSPITALITY

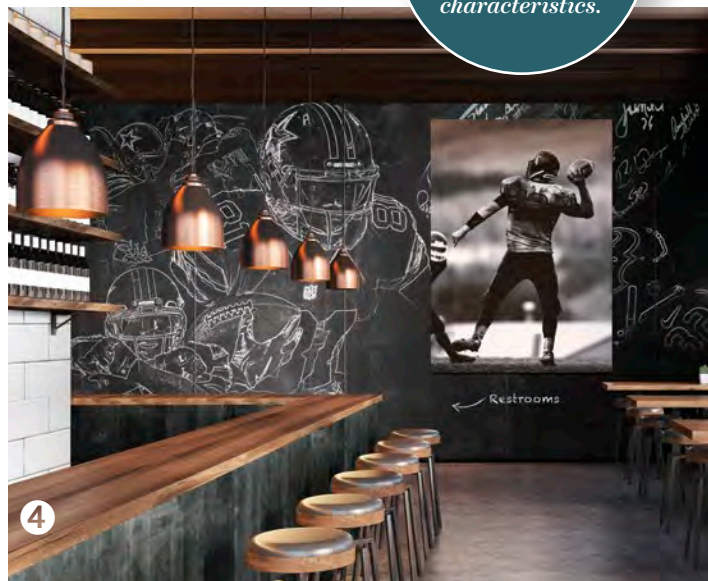

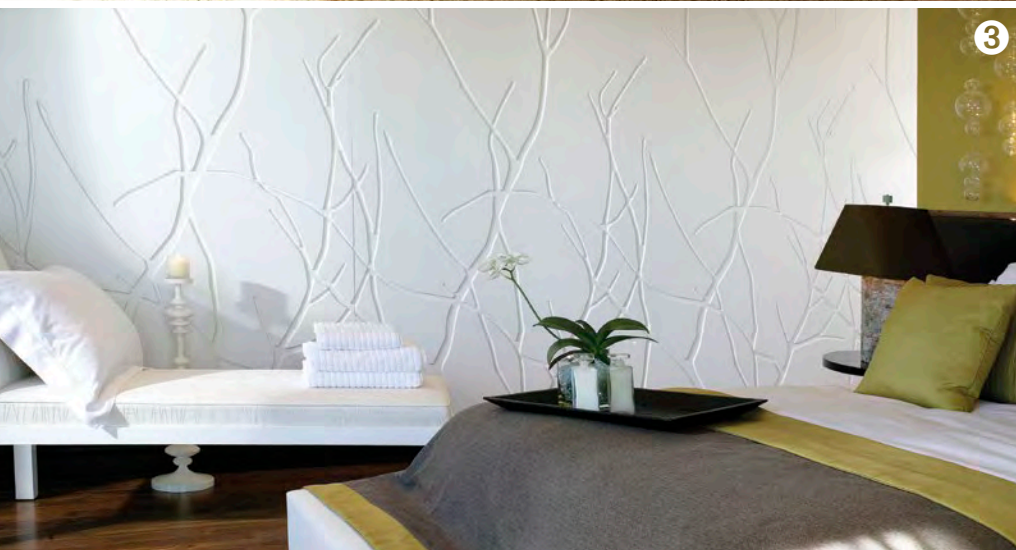
